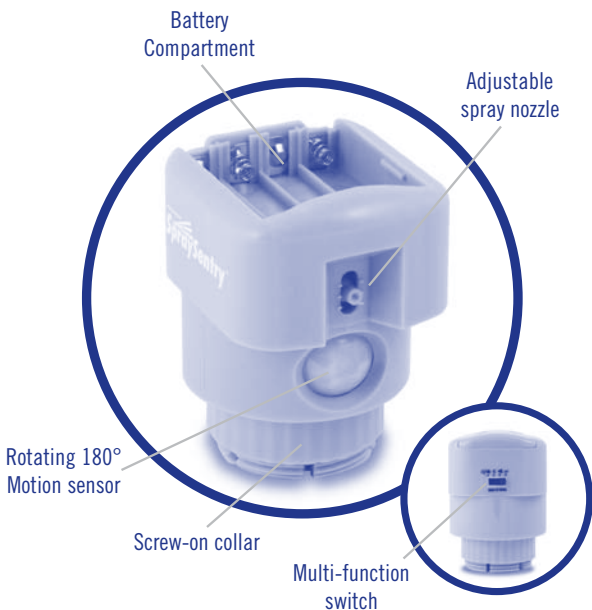
# **SpraySentry™**

*Cat Deterrent System*

This unique spray deterrent system blends innovative spray technology with an adjustable motion sensor capable of detecting movement within five feet of a designated area. How does it work? Once the motion sensor identifies an intruder, the device is activated and able to deliver a number of different warnings ranging from an audible tone to burst of compressed air. The spray is odorless, completely harmless and yet proven to be highly effective in deterring your cat from jumping on counters, digging in potted plants, or roaming freely throughout the house.



## This system includes:



- Spray device
- 3-position spray nozzle
- 5-position rotating motion sensor with an effective range of 5 feet
- 4-function switch...SPRAY, TONE, TONE & SPRAY and OFF
- 4.5 oz. can of Premier branded stain-free, hypoallergenic scentless spray
- Lifetime warranty
- Indoor use ONLY



# Preparing the system

## Insert the batteries

To insert the batteries, first press down on the battery cover and slide it back. (figure 1) Insert each of 4 AAA batteries (figure 2) making sure the + on the battery lines up with the + in the battery compartment. Replace the battery cover.

## Attach the spray device

Place the spray device on top of the spray can and press down firmly. (figure 3) While pressing the device onto the can screw the collar down by turning in a clockwise motion. (figure 4) Once the collar is tight to the can the device should be securely fastened.

## Position the system

Place the system in close proximity to the object or area you are looking to protect, e.g., counter, plant, furniture, etc. The relationship between the motion sensor and direction of spray can be adjusted as needed. (figure 5) The spray nozzle can also be adjusted up or down. (figure 6)

## Activate the system

It's recommended that you introduce the system using the strongest correction...the combination of TONE & SPRAY. Set the switch (figure 7) and wait a few seconds (no more than 5) for the motion detector to stabilize. Once stabilized the system will be 'active' and ready to test.

### Note

Should it become necessary to narrow the motion sensor's range, just cover a portion or portions of the sensor eye using an opaque material such as masking tape.

## Test the system

To test the system you need only pass your hand by the motion detector. (figure 8) When operating properly the device will recognize movement and trigger a correction...first a warning tone followed immediately by a short burst of spray. If for any reason your device fails to respond in this manner, check to see that the batteries were installed properly, turn the device off and start again.

## Adjust the system as needed

After a few days it may no longer be necessary to correct using both TONE and SPRAY. At that point you have the option of backing off a bit and switching to either TONE or SPRAY. (figure 9) Depending on the animal either correction should be highly effective.

## Remove the spray device

To remove the spray device from the aerosol can, turn the unit OFF...loosen the screw-on collar (figure 10)...and lift the device from the can.

# Conditioning tips

## Placement

Make every effort to avoid letting your cat see you place the system.

## Daily use

Turn the system OFF whenever anyone other than the cat might trigger a correction.

## Adjusting the correction...message

After a few days of using the TONE & SPRAY, you might consider switching to the TONE mode. Your cat should now be conditioned to associate the correction merely by sound. Observe your cat and if you notice it revisiting an unwanted behavior reset the device to TONE & SPRAY and re-start the conditioning process.

**Note** Cats are fast learners and it is highly recommended that you alternate TONE and SPRAY corrections on a regular basis.

## Repositioning the system

In order to generalize your cat's learning it's recommended that after a week or so you move the SpraySenty a few feet away from its original place. This way your cat will learn to avoid an increasing larger area over time.

## Using positive reinforcement

Use positive reinforcement...food or affection...when your cat respects the zone or responds appropriately to the re-direction. By using positive reinforcement you will contribute to your pet's well being and keep harmony in the family.



## Spray refills

The SpraySentry spray refill contains 100% HFC-134a gas (1,1,1,2, Tetrafluoroethane) and is safe for people, animals and the environment. It has no active chemical agent and is therefore stainless, harmless and ozone-friendly. You can expect to get well over 200 sprays from an 8 oz. can.
